ARTS EDUCATION INTERN

Brief Organization Overview:

Pomona Hope is a non-profit, faith-based, community organization dedicated to working in partnership with people of all backgrounds to strengthen Pomona's children, families, and neighborhoods.

After School with Pomona Hope welcomes kindergarteners through twelfth graders. We are dedicated to working alongside parents and community members on behalf of Pomona's youth. It is our aim to provide resources and a safe, affirming environment to empower youth to grow and learn.

In conjunction with other Pomona Hope programs, the Arts at Pomona Hope provides art workshops and enrichment experiences to students and families. Partnering with local students, artists, and arts organizations, we are able to uniquely engage the entire Pomona Hope community through both visual and performing arts.

Description:

- Develop and execute a variety of age appropriate workshops to expose students to different artistic forms. Sample artistic forms: drawing, painting, theater, dance, crafts, etc. Workshops should encourage relationship building among students and volunteers.
- Compile a curriculum of lesson plans that can be utilized by the program in the future
- Manage back hallway gallery space; rotate art frequently
- Assist with planning and execution of events and field trips
- Plan for and execute on-site art showcase toward end of semester
- Attend one arts field trip during the semester
- Assist staff with program preparations at least 1 hour/week
- Other duties as assigned

The Arts Education Intern should have a passion for the arts and for deepening their desire to learn more about social justice and child development. This internship is a great opportunity to explore the field of arts education in a fun and creative way.
